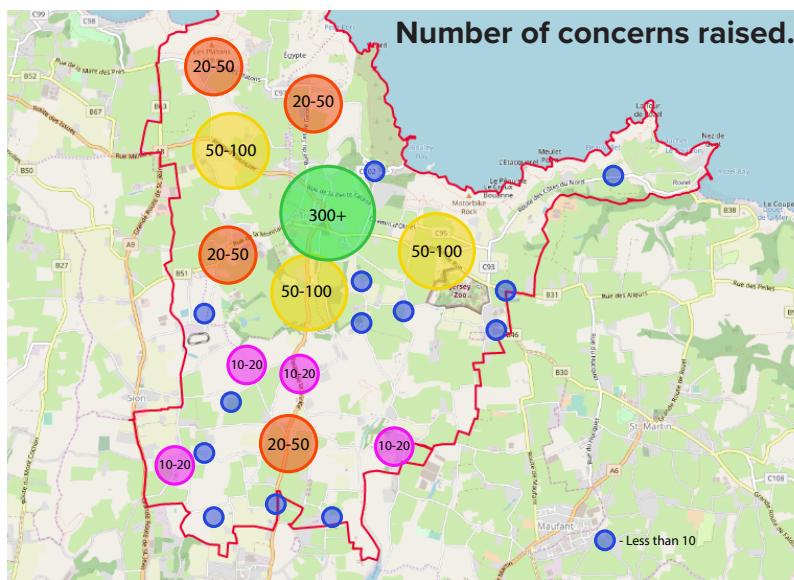

What would help with greener, safer, travel in Trinity?

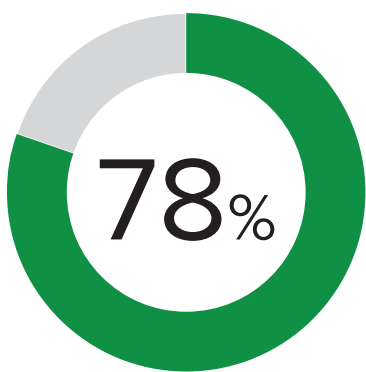
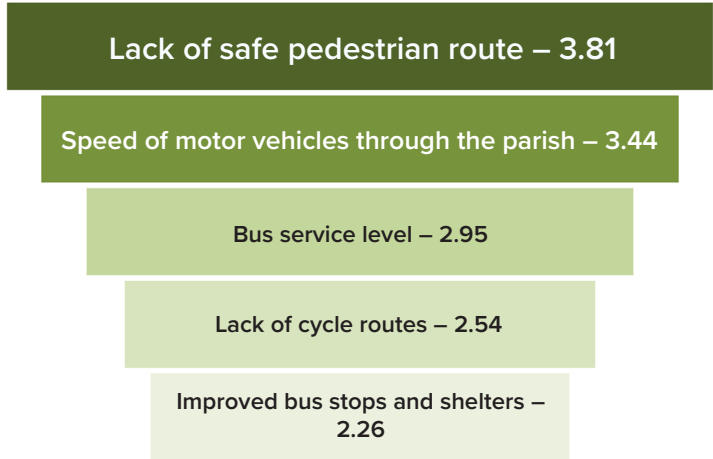
– Results!

'Our community project board recently asked Parishioners their views on the barriers to active travel both in the historic centre of the parish and across the parish. We have been very impressed with the excellent level engagement with 321 responses. The responses show that the parish already has an above average bus and cycling usage when compared to other rural passages. We hope that with making some further interventions to make it safer to walk, cycle and travel by bus, these figure will get even better and help towards both the Parishes and the Islands carbon reductions ambitions. The board have asked the technical team to develop a range of options that respond to the concerns raised with an aim to consult on these in 2022.'

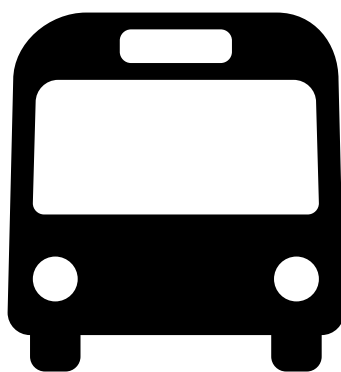

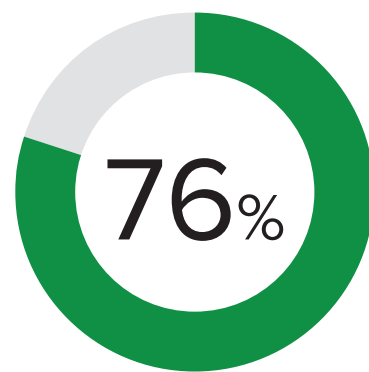
Please rank the following concerns in order of importance to you?
